

Instructions for the Valley Dental Arts Scholarship

All application materials are due by **March 17, 2017.** Late applications and materials will not be considered. Any hand written application will be disqualified. All application materials must be sent via email to: <u>scholarships@thehaef.org</u>. You will be notified of your application status via E-mail by May 31, 2017.

Applicants Must Meet All Criteria Listed

- A U.S. citizen or legal resident alien.
- Will be attending an accredited private/public college or university.
- Any person of Hmong descent pursuing an education to better himself or herself and others.
- A Minnesota state resident.
- Any high school senior, high school or GED graduate or current college student is eligible.
- Has been accepted fulltime to a 2-year or 4-year college/university in the Fall 2017 2018 academic year.
- Has a minimum GPA of 3.0 in a 4.0 scale system.
- Must be majoring in Science or Engineering related fields.
- Based on need and hardship.

Scholarship Application Packet, Checklist

- A completed application.
- Essay (1500 words or less).
- Copy of unofficial transcript.
- One letter of recommendation.
- All required application documents should be sent in PDF format via E-mail to scholarships@thehaef.org

A Successful applicant must demonstrate the following

- A commitment to excellent academic achievement.
- A commitment to helping your community.
- Demonstrates financial needs, difficulties or hardships.

Essay: In one essay, 1500 words or less, please answer the following questions

- 1. Tell us about your commitment to education.
- 2. Tell us some of the things you have done to help your community.
- 3. Tell us your needs and how this scholarship can help you.

Additional Requirements

- Recipients are expected to attend the Scholarship Awards Banquet on the first Saturday of August 2017.
- If selected, recipients are expected to submit the documents requested for the Scholarship Awards Banquet (ex. photo, bio, thank you letter to donors).

Successful applicants are required to attend two general academic coaching, and mentoring sessions with

HAEF. These sessions can be done via phone, e-mail or face to face.
