- A Minnesota state resident.
- A high school senior or has earned a high school or GED diploma is eligible.
- Has been accepted to Saint Paul College in the Fall 2017-2018 academic year.

Additional Requirements

- Recipient is expected to attend the Scholarship Awards Banquet on the first Saturday of August 2017.
- If selected, recipients are expected to submit the documents requested for the Scholarship Awards Banquet (ex. photo, bio, thank you letter to donors).
